

TOWN OF MANSURA  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
JUNE 12, 2023

The Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Mansura met in regular session at the Mansura Town Hall on Monday, June 12, 2023, at six o'clock.

The meeting opened with a prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Alderman Bruce Jackson, Glenn McKinley, and Roderick Perry, Alderwoman Judy Bazert, and Judy James.

Mayor Pickett and the Board of Alderman presented a plaque in honor of Samuel Simon II to his parents for his musical gift "Welcome to Louisiana", a great inspiration for the state's festivals throughout Louisiana.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Alderman that Mr. Spencer Gauthier with Pan American engineers couldn't make it to the meeting, so the mayor presented the engineer report on Bayou Lacombe, Love Louisiana Outdoors, and Water System Improvements.

Town Attorney Alissa Piazza addressed the Mayor and Board of Alderman with the autopsy for the Police Jury, overgrown grass, and citizen's complaint form. Town Attorney informed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about paying the autopsy bill for the Police Jury. Motioned by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Bruce Jackson and unanimously carried to approve and adopt the proposed amendment budget for June 30, 2023.


