

TOWN OF MANSURA
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 9, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Mansura met on February 9, 2026, at six o'clock. The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Mayor Pro-Tempore Bruce Jackson, Alderman Glenn McKinley, Alderwoman Judy James, and Lucille Hayes.

Mr. Chris Jeansonne from Computers PC 911 addressed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about two quotes for internet services for the town/police department and Pavillion Hall with Conterra. Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried to approve to switch internet services from Brightspeed to Conterra for the town/police department and Pavillion Hall.

Mr. Thomas David from Pan American Engineers updated the Mayor and Board of Alderman about Bayou Lacombe, LGAP application, Desfosse House, and Pavillion Grant.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Alderman that he is still inquiring about the former Red River Charter School campus.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried to accept and adopt the minutes of the January 12, 2026, meeting.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried to approve January bills for payment.

The financial statement for January was viewed by town council.

General fund, Sales 01, and Sales 02 were compared to the budget.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Alderman that the DAV will no longer be using the town hall meeting room to help veterans file VA disability claims, but when internet services get installed in the Pavillion, they'll be welcome to use it for that purpose.

Mrs. Kristy St. Romain gave an updated Fire Department report for Chief Bruce Jeansonne.

A temporary BURN BAN has been issued for all Avoyelles Parish.
