

TOWN OF MANSURA
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
NOVEMBER 10, 2025

The Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Mansura met on November 10, 2025 at six o'clock.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Mayor Pro-Tempore Bruce Jackson, Alderwoman Judy James and Judy Bazert.

Absent: Alderman Roderick Perry

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried to add Alderman Roderick Perry resignation to the agenda.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Alderman that council member Roderick Perry mailed off his written resignation letter to Baton Rouge today November 10, 2025, and the town must wait to receive information back from Baton Rouge for the next steps.

Mr. Thomas David from Pan American Engineers updated the Mayor and Board of Alderman about Bayou Lacombe.

Alderwoman Judy James informed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about the Veterans Day Ball in the Cochon de Lait Center tomorrow from 4pm to 7pm and Paragon Casino Resort Veterans Day Program at 10am.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Judy Bazert and unanimously carried to accept resolution to submit a Water Sector funding application for Wastewater System Improvements.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Judy Bazert and unanimously carried to adopt ordinance # 11-10-25 Sewer User Fees effective December 1, 2025.

Motioned by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Bruce Jackson and unanimously carried to adopt Avoyelles Parish Residential and Commercial Fee Schedule for building permits.

Town attorney Alissa Piazza informed the Mayor and Board of Alderman she did not forget about sending a letter to LAWCO about the franchise fees. Mayor Pickett informed the town attorney about seeing if someone from LAWCO can come to the town meeting.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Alderman that the Christmas parade will be December 6, 2025 at one o'clock.

Motioned by Judy Bazert, seconded by Bruce Jackson and unanimously carried to approve \$400.00 of candy for the Christmas parade.

Motioned by Judy Bazert, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried to accept and adopt the minutes of the October 13, 2025 meeting.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried to approve October bills for payment.

The financial statement for October was viewed by town council.

General fund, Sales 01, and Sales 02 were compared to the budget.

Mrs. Kristy St. Romain gave an updated Fire Department report for Chief Bruce Jeansonne.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Glenn McKinley and unanimously carried having no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
