

TOWN OF MANSURA
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 8, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mansura met on June 8, 2026, at six o'clock.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Mayor Pro-Tempore Bruce Jackson, Alderman Glenn McKinley, Alderwoman Lucille Hayes, Judy Bazert, and Judy James.

Mrs. Cheryl Jackson with NAACP addressed the Mayor and Board of Aldermen about getting people in the community to join the group. Fees are \$30.00 a year and they meet on the first Monday of each month at 6:30p.m. in the Hampton Inn conference room in Marksville. They also hold meetings in the community and meet with the different mayors about things going on in the community.

Mrs. Danielle Phillips addressed the Mayor and Board of Aldermen about Growing Readers & Hearts Foundation for children. She would like to host the event in the Cochon de Lait Center in August.

Alderwoman Judy James informed Mrs. Danielle that she is doing a Back-to-School Event for the town and will get with her.

Mr. Ethan from Pan American Engineers gave the Mayor and Board of Aldermen an update on Bayou Lacombe, and Defosse House.

Town Attorney Alissa Piazza addressed the Mayor and Board of Aldermen about May Street extension. It is not a town road, it's private property.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Aldermen about the LMA Convention in Monroe August 4-6, 26.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Aldermen that the Sales Tax 2 renewal that didn't pass will go back on the December ballot. The tax is due to be renewed on July 1, 2027.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Aldermen that the baseball field is locked. If anyone wants to have a baseball tournament they must call the town, have insurance and security for the event." No backpacks or alcoholic beverages are allowed.

Motioned by Judy James, seconded by Judy Bazert and unanimously carried to add Mr. Welsey Elmer to the agenda.

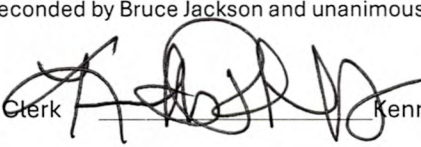
Mr. Welsey Elmer addressed the Mayor and Board of Aldermen regarding his candidacy for Judge, Division B.
