

TOWN OF MANSURA
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 11, 2026

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Mansura met on May 11, 2026, at 6:00p.m.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Mayor Pro-Tempore Bruce Jackson, Alderman Glenn McKinley, Alderwoman Lucille Hayes, Judy James, and Judy Bazert.

Motioned by Judy Bazert, seconded by Bruce Jackson and unanimously carried to add Rev. Guillory to the agenda.

Rev. Guillory addressed the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on behalf of the Kilsons regarding the damaged bridge leading to their house and access to their property. Mayor Pickett informed the Town Attorney to look into the matter.

Motioned by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Bruce Jackson and unanimously carried to add Mr. Brent Poret to the agenda.

Mr. Brent Poret addressed the Mayor and Board of Aldermen regarding building a road for a project near the Old Ace Hardware Store. The Town Attorney will review all paperwork related to the donation of this road and discuss the matter with the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

Mr. Ethan from Pan American Engineers gave the Mayor and Board of Aldermen an update on the Bayou Lacombe Project. Mayor Pickett, Turner & Turner Associates, and the company that made the matting visited the site to inspect the matting that did not harden properly.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Aldermen about the District F meeting on June 16, 2026, at 6:00p.m. at the Carencro Community Center.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Aldermen about repairs to Tony Roy Road. One quote has already been received, and Mr. Ethan was asked to obtain two additional quotes.

Mayor Pickett informed the Board of Aldermen that he is still inquiring about the former Red River Charter School campus.

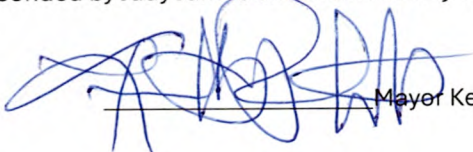
The financial statement for April was reviewed by the Town Council.
