

TOWN OF MANSURA
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 8, 2023

The Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Mansura met in regular session at the Mansura Town Hall on Monday, May 8, 2023, at six o'clock.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Alderman Bruce Jackson, Glenn McKinley, and Roderick Perry, Alderwoman Judy Bazert, and Judy James.

Ryan Barton from Pan American Engineers informed the Mayor and Board of Alderman that he had looked into who other municipalities have surveillance cameras with. He suggests that the best one to go with would be Chase Communications.

Town Attorney Alissa Piazza Tassin informed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about the meeting she had with Florensa Pickett, Judy James, and Judy Bazert about the First Annual Youth Summer Camp for the kids.
