

TOWN OF MANSURA  
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING  
DECEMBER 12, 2022

The Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Mansura met in regular session at the Mansura Town Hall on Monday, December 12, 2022, at six o'clock.

Present: Mayor Kenneth Pickett, Alderman Bruce Jackson, Gaon Escude, Roderick Perry, and Shawn Wilson.

Absent: Judy Bazert.

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Kenneth Pickett thanked Mr. Goan Escude for his years as a councilman saying, "He will truly be missed."

Mr. Ryan Barton from Pan American Engineers updated the Mayor and Board of Alderman about the Love Louisiana Outdoors Program.

Motioned by Bruce Jackson, seconded by Goan Escude and unanimously carried to approve the Love Louisiana Outdoors Program Resolutions.

Florensa Pickett addressed the Mayor and Board of Alderman about the Mansura youth summer camp for kids in 2023.
